a. <u>Quarterly Review</u>: Chair Despres informed the Board that Silver Creek was liquidating its investment in hedge funds and reviewed quarterly report from consultant.

- b. <u>Aether Capital Investment Partners</u>: Chair Despres reported on a site visit to Aether which was favorable. Upon motion by Chair Despres and second by Trustee Berry, the Board unanimously approved a \$10 million investment in Aether (private equity natural resources).
- c. <u>Kingdom Capital Management & Clovis Capital Partners</u>: Upon motion by Trustee Despres and second by Trustee Hall, the Board unanimously approved an additional \$1 million investment each in Kingdom and Clovis investments (hedge funds).

- 4. <u>Legislative</u>: Chair Clancy briefed the Board on possible plan design issues that need to be considered in light of PPACA (September 15, 2010 meeting to discuss).
