

Minutes of the Annual Meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Fire and Police Retiree Health Care Fund, San Antonio February 8, 2023

> At 8:30 a.m., Chair Berry called the meeting to order. The roll was called, and a quorum was declared present.

EXECUTIVE

SESSION: The Board went into Executive Session at 5:25 p.m. to discuss legal issues regarding Executive Director's contract and compensation. The Executive Session

adjourned at 6:22 p.m.

ACTION ITEMS:

> Presentation by WEB-TPA: WEB representatives briefed the Board on performance under the contract, including cost containment, customer service, while handling 120,216 claims at a cost of \$18.4M. (Top 10 claimants account for 21% of plan spend). Only 30% of population are using clinics. Average processing time is 4.7 days. Average age for customers is 68 for males.

- 2. <u>Presentation by WellDyne</u>: Welldyne reported over \$10.7M total savings/cost avoidance for drug use. Top 3 Drugs: Ozempic (diabetes), Humira Pen (arthritis), and Trulicity (diabetes).
- 3. <u>Presentation by USI</u>: Recommended a PIP for Welldyne to address personnel issues. No action taken.
- 4. <u>Foster & Foster</u>: Presentation by full-service actuarial consulting firms with a focus on fire and police funds to provide both actuarial and benefit issues. Also will provide assistance with legislative amendments if necessary. Foster will submit proposals for engagement.
- 5. <u>Presentation by Health by Design</u>: 24,000 appointments, with top diagnoses as follows:

Diabetes – 30%

Heart – 16%

Bones/Joints: 11%

Targeted Healthcare: Coaching, PT, Case navigation, behavioral health, well-being exams.
